Time Verification Procedures

Our personnel will request that you sign a time slip to verify hours worked, on a weekly basis. The time slip is essential to establish accurate records of services rendered for billing purposes and payment to employee. Hi-Tech Services

Our full spectrum of health services include:

- **Intravenous Therapy**
Professional nurses, in conjunction with an infusion therapy organization, are available to administer antibiotic, chemotherapy and parenteral treatments.
- **Oncology**
Skilled professionals, well versed about the process, treatment and pain management of cancer, provide the support system necessary for patients and family to cope with the physical and emotional aspects of the disease.
- **Rehabilitation**
A multi-level approach to treatment and rehabilitation of the severely injured patient. Program levels are based upon the patient's cognitive status and are administered in conjunction with a physician and therapist.
- **Ventilator Therapy**
Specialized nursing care for patients placed on mechanical ventilator therapy includes careful monitoring to detect changing conditions, weaning of the patient and psychological considerations.

Loving Hands Personnel

Registered Nurse

Assesses, plans, implements and evaluates patient's needs. Develops and update care plans and working directly with the physician to meet the needs of the patient and family member. Administer medications, treatments and procedures.

Licensed Practical Nurse

Under supervision of a Registered Nurse, provides care prescribed by a physician. Administers medication, takes vital signs, assist in educating self-care techniques.

Home Health Aide

Performs fundamental nursing task such as monitoring temperature and vital assessment. Assist with personnel hygiene, nutritional planning & light housekeeping.

Companion

Handles meal planning and preparation. Helps in supervision of the client while the primary caregiver attends to their personal duties.

Live-In

Twenty-four hour patient supervision. Assist with patients medical care as well as household needs.



Physical Therapist

Assist with patient activities, including transfers and ambulation, prosthetic training, in order to help prevent, identify, correct or alleviate acute or chronic movement dysfunction.

Occupational Therapist

Evaluates and treats those whose abilities to cope with daily activities are impaired by developmental deficits, injury, illness, psychological and social disability.

Respiratory Therapist

Treats, manages, control and diagnostically evaluates patient care for cardiopulmonary system dysfunction.

Speech Therapist

Works with patients whose communication skills have been diminished by illness; helps restore or compensate for lost speech or language.

Visiting Nurse

Formulates specific, based on initial evaluation, in conjunction with the assigned home care professional, patient and/or family. Plans is updated as patient progresses; major emphasis is placed on education and training of the patient and family.

Physician
